# Built with Horizons Program: Official Rules and Guidelines

Welcome to "Built with Horizons"! This initiative is designed to showcase the incredible projects created by our community, provide visibility, and reward innovation. By participating, you agree to the following terms and conditions ("Rules and Guidelines").

Hostinger reserves the right to change these Rules and Guidelines at any time by giving notice on the "Built with Horizons" page or notify you of changes or modifications to these Rules and Guidelines by email (if material changes are made).

## 1. Legal Agreements and Consent

Before submitting your project to the "Built with Horizons" gallery, you must agree to the following legal policies and consents. These are crucial for ensuring a transparent and secure environment for all participants.

<u>Terms of Service</u>: Your participation in "Built with Horizons" is subject to Hostinger Universal Terms of Service (including <u>Hostinger Horizons Special Terms</u>), which govern your use of our platform and services. This includes provisions on account responsibility, acceptable use, and general legal disclaimers.

<u>Privacy Policy</u>: We are committed to protecting your privacy. Our Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, and safeguard your personal information. By participating, you acknowledge that you have read and understand this policy.

**Intellectual Property Rights**: You retain all ownership rights to the intellectual property in your project. However, by submitting your project, you grant Hostinger a non-exclusive, worldwide, royalty-free, perpetual, irrevocable, and sublicensable license to use, reproduce, modify, adapt, publish, translate, create derivative works from, distribute, perform, and display your project and its related materials (including descriptions, screenshots, videos, and any accompanying text) for the purposes outlined below.

### **Consent for Marketing and Promotional Use:**

By submitting your project, you explicitly agree that Hostinger may use your submitted project and all related materials (including, but not limited to, project descriptions, screenshots, videos, and your project name/logo) for marketing, promotional, and showcase purposes. This includes displaying your project in the "Built with Horizons" gallery, featuring it on our website, sharing it across our social media channels (e.g., YouTube, X, Meta), in newsletters, press releases, and other promotional materials, without further compensation or notification. This consent is essential for us to highlight your work and promote the "Built with Horizons" initiative.

## 2. Contest Rules and Gifting

The "Built with Horizons" program includes a contest component where top-voted projects will receive prizes. Participation in the contest is subject to these specific rules:

## Eligibility:

- Participants must be at least 18 years of age or the age of majority in their jurisdiction of residence at the time of submission.
- Projects must be created using the Hostinger Horizons platform and currently be actively hosted on Hostinger's platform.
- Employees of Hostinger, its affiliates, and their immediate family members are not eligible to win prizes.
- Void where prohibited by law.

#### Submission Period:

#### Voting Mechanics:

- Voting will occur through a public upvote system on the "Built with Horizons" gallery page.
- Each user may cast one vote per project.
- Any attempt to manipulate votes through automated means, false accounts, or other fraudulent methods will result in immediate disqualification.

#### Winner Selection:

- Winners will be determined based on the total number of legitimate upvotes received by their project within the designated voting period.
- In the event of a tie, a panel of Hostinger appointed judges will select the winner based on criteria such as innovation, design, functionality, and adherence to content guidelines under these Rules and Guidelines.

#### Prizes:

- Prizes will be awarded to the top-voted projects. The specific nature and value of prizes (e.g., Hostinger Horizons credits, merchandise, promotional features) will be announced on the "Built with Horizons" program page and may vary.
- Prizes are non-transferable and no cash equivalent will be offered.
- Winners are responsible for any applicable taxes or duties associated with prize receipt.

#### Winner Notification and Claim:

• Winners will be notified via the email address associated with their Hostinger Horizons account after the voting period has ended.

 Winners must respond to the notification and provide any requested information within 7 days to claim their prize. Failure to respond within this timeframe may result in forfeiture of the prize, and an alternate winner may be selected.

By accepting a prize, winners agree to allow Hostinger to use their project name, and likeness for promotional purposes without additional compensation, except where prohibited by law.

#### Disqualification:

Hostinger reserves the right to disqualify any project or participant that violates these rules, attempts to manipulate the voting process, submits fraudulent information, or engages in any activity deemed detrimental to the spirit of the program. All decisions by Hostinger regarding eligibility and winners are final.

#### 3. Content Guidelines

To maintain a positive and safe environment for our community, all submitted projects must adhere to the following content standards:

#### **Prohibited Content:**

- Malware, Viruses, or Harmful Code: Any software designed to damage or gain unauthorized access to computer systems.
- Scams or Fraudulent Material: Content intended to deceive users or facilitate illegal activities.
- Explicit or Adult Material: Pornography, sexually explicit content, or content depicting nudity in a non-artistic or non-educational context.
- Violent or Hateful Content: Content that promotes violence, incites hatred against individuals or groups based on race, ethnicity, religion, gender, sexual orientation, disability, or any other protected characteristic.
- Illegal Activities: Content that promotes, facilitates, or depicts illegal activities, or is in any other way tied to illegal or sanctioned activities.
- Infringement of Rights: Content that infringes upon the intellectual property rights (copyright, trademark, patent) or privacy rights of any third party.
- Harassment or Bullying: Content that harasses, bullies, or defames any individual or group.
- Misinformation or Disinformation: Content that is demonstrably false or misleading and could cause harm.

#### **Quality Standards:**

• Projects should be functional and provide a clear purpose or demonstration.

- Descriptions and related materials should be accurate and clearly represent the project.
- Projects should be relevant to the capabilities of the Hostinger Horizons platform.
